



# EEA and Norway Grants for projects 2014-2021

The EEA and Norway Grants 2014-2021\* represent funding from Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway to reduce economic and social disparities and strengthen cooperation with 15 EU countries in Central and Southern Europe and the Baltics. For the period 2014-2021, a total contribution of €2.8 billion has been agreed for programmes tackling major challenges Europe is facing.

## Partnership

Projects that are agreed upon in the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for your country together with donor partners, which are not subject to calls for funding, are known as pre-defined projects. The Norwegian Mapping Authority is interested in acting as Donor Project Partner for these types of projects. We will assist in developing a project proposal and later in implementation of the project activities.

## To-do list for applicants

- Determine the programme area of interest to you. Check [eeagrants.org](http://eeagrants.org) to see which program areas are supported by your country or whether there are any calls for proposals. Check [eeagrants.org](http://eeagrants.org) > Partnerships > Donor Programme Partners for a list of potential project partners from Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway. Contact the respective agencies who can be Donor Project Partners with your ideas.
- With the assistance of a project partner in Norway and Iceland, develop a project proposal of 1-2 pages specifying the content and expected results, relation to EEA focus areas, the amount applied for, partners, experience with the partners, and risk analysis. The project partner sends the project proposal to their Ministry of Foreign Affairs and by the applicants to their respective National Focal Point for the EEA mechanism.

\* The EEA Grants are jointly financed by all three donors, where contributions are based on their GDP. The estimated share of contributions equates to: Norway (96%), Iceland (3%) and Liechtenstein (1%).

Projects can be carried out together with neighboring countries, and regional funds (€34.5 million) are available to promote regional cooperation.
